Overview: Apple has new requirements for publishing and updating apps in their App Store. Apple now requires apps to be published on their own developer account. In the past, we published apps on our developer account.

How does this affect the schools we serve? We need its own Apple Developer account. Once setup, we will be able to publish apps on our own account.

What's the process and where are we at in the process? In short we are almost done.

Step 1 : Setup an Apple ID

We will setup an Apple ID with the following information:

Step 3 : Apple Developer Account

We will apply for the account with the following information:

- a. Apple will very likely want to schedule a call to verify two things**
 1. You wish to setup an Apple Developer Account
 2. You have the authority to sign up for the Developer Account
 3. Answer "yes" to both of these questions
